SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 1535, L.D. 2162, "Resolve, to Authorize the Maine State Museum to Purchase Historic Maine Artifacts"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

**'Sec. 1. Funding for historic artifacts. Resolved:** That, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 162, subsection 12-A, the Legislative Council may authorize expenditures in fiscal year 1997-98 from the Reserve Fund for State House Preservation and Maintenance for the purchase of historic artifacts for the Maine State Museum. Notwithstanding Title 5, section 1507, subsections 1 to 6, the Governor may authorize expenditures in fiscal year 1997-98 from the State Contingent Account for the purchase of historic artifacts for the Maine State Museum.'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

12 This amendment removes the proposed General Fund  
appropriation in fiscal year 1997-98 of \$162,000 and replaces it  
with a new section that authorizes the purchase of historic  
14 artifacts, utilizing funds available in the State Contingent  
Account and the Reserve Fund for State House Preservation and  
16 Maintenance.
