Sec. 1. Resolve 1997, c. 66, §§6 to 8, amended. Resolved: That Resolve 1997, c. 66, §§6 to 8 are amended to read:

Sec. 6. Reimbursement. Resolved: That the members of the 4 task force who are Legislators are entitled to receive the legislative per diem as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, 6 Title 3, section 2 and reimbursement for travel and other 8 necessary expenses for attendance at meetings of the task force upon application to the Executive Director of the Legislative 10 Council for those expenses. Members appointed to represent the business community may be reimbursed for expenses. Other members are not entitled to reimbursement of expenses; and be it further 12

14 Sec. 7. Report. Resolved: That the task force shall submit its report, which must include a plan to implement a single-form filing and payment system for state and federal taxes for use by small businesses, together with any necessary implementing legislation, to the Second First Regular Session of the 118th 119th Legislature no later than January 1, 1998 1999. If the task force requires an extension, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension; and be it further

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Sec. 8. Meetings. Resolved: That the task force may meet up to 4 times in 1997 and up to 12 times in 1998; and be it further

26 Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This resolve applies retroactively to January 1, 1998.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

This resolve amends the resolve that created the Task Force on State and Federal Tax Filing to extend the reporting date for one year and authorize expenses for members of the task force appointed to represent the business community. It authorizes the task force to meet up to 12 times during 1998.

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
