Presented by Representative McALEVEY of Waterboro. Cosponsored by Senator LIBBY of York. **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, 2 large fires during the 1990's within the Town of 6 Limerick have illustrated the inadequacy of the fire protection available through the Limerick Water District, and in particular 8 the need to increase the size of the primary water main through the town; and

Whereas, the Department of Human Services has indicated to 12 the Limerick Water District that its system reservoir is in disrepair and needs to be replaced in order to maintain the 14 quality of the water supply; and

16 Whereas, the Limerick Water District plans to address these deficiencies in 1998 by constructing a new reservoir and 18 replacing the primary water main, which will in turn require the district to borrow funds in excess of the debt limit established 20 in its charter. These funds must be obtained during the spring of 1998 in order to permit construction during the summer and 22 fall of that year; and

Whereas, in conjunction with the Limerick Water District's financing efforts, the Town of Limerick is in the process of
procuring a community development block grant from the State, which will be lost if not utilized for construction during 1998;
and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1957, c. 219, §10, first sentence is amended to read:

40 For accomplishing the purposes of this act, and for such other expenses as may be necessary for the carrying out of said purposes, said district, through its trustees, without district 42 vote, is authorized to borrow money temporarily and to issue therefor its negotiable notes, and for the purpose of renewing 44 and refunding the indebtedness so created, of paying any necessary expenses and liabilities incurred under the provisions 46 act, including organizational and other necessary of this expenses and liabilities whether incurred by the district or the 48 Town of Limerick, the district being authorized to reimburse

said Town of Limerick for any such expenses incurred by it, and 2 in acquiring properties, paying damages, laying pipes, mains, aqueducts and conduits, constructing, maintaining and operating a water plant or system and making renewals, additions, extensions 4 and improvements to the same, and to cover interest payments 6 during the period of construction, said district, through its trustees, without district vote, is also authorized to issue, 8 from time to time, bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness of the district in one series, or in separate series, in such amount or amounts, bearing interest at such rate 10 or rates, and having such terms and provisions as the trustees 12 shall determine +-- provided - that -- the - total -- indebtedness - of -- said district-at-any-ono-time-outstanding-shall-not-oxcood-the-sum-of 14 \$200,000.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

SUMMARY

This bill removes the current debt limit within the charter of the Limerick Water District.
