HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 813, L.D. 2195, Bill, "An Act Concerning Enforcement of Parking Spaces for Persons with Physical Disabilities"

Amend the amendment by inserting before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §521, sub-§8, as repealed and replaced by PL 1995, c. 482, Pt. A, §4, is repealed.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.
