This bill General appropriation of includes Fund а 18 \$4,000,000 in fiscal year 1998-99 for the University of Maine System for the first year of a 5-year funding strategy for the 20 Maine Economic Improvement Fund. The repeal of a provision in Public Law 1997, chapter 643, Part HH, section 3 that included a General Fund appropriation of \$4,000,000 in fiscal year 1998-99 22 to the Finance Authority of Maine for the Maine Student Incentive 24 Scholarship Program offsets the General Fund appropriation in this bill, resulting in no net fiscal impact to the General Fund 26 in fiscal year 1998-99.

28 The bill also replaces a provision authorizing a transfer of \$4,000,000 of available balances at June 30, 1998 to the 30 University of Maine System with an authorization to transfer the same amount to the Finance Authority of Maine at June 30, 1998.' 32

## SUMMARY

36 This amendment repeals the additional funding of \$4,000,000 to the Maine Student Incentive Scholarship Program and the 38 authorization in Public Law 1997, chapter 643 to transfer an amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 to the University of Maine System 40 toward the Maine Economic Improvement Strategy effective June 30, 1998. This amendment also reduces the appropriation to the Maine Economic Improvement Fund from \$10,000,000 to \$4,000,000. 42

The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
