Revenues to the fund б The Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System shall take all actions necessary to obtain revenue from sources 8 other than the General Fund, including revenues from intellectual property arising from research or joint ventures funded by the 10 fund and to ensure that those revenues replace General Fund 12 appropriations by June 30, 2003.
