30	serve for 2 years. Members continue serving until a successor is duly appointed and qualified. When a vacancy occurs during a member's term, the vacancy must be filled, by the appropriate
32	appointing authority, from the same category listed in subsection 1 as the member who vacated the committee.

36	3. Purpose. The committee shall advise the Legislature on ways to improve economic development opportunities for all regions of the State. The committee shall:

	entitled to compensation as provided in section 12004-I,
18	subsection 6-E. All other members serve without compensation.
