SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 823, L.D. 2212, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Authority of the Adjutant General to Sell Armories, to Increase the Authorized Size of the Veterans' Memorial Cemetery and to Authorize the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to Purchase Land in Houlton for a New Public Safety Facility"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "parcels" and inserting in its place the following: 'parcel'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in paragraph G (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Armory;" and inserting in its place the following: 'Armory; and'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in paragraph H in the last line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "446; and" and inserting in its place the following: '446.'


Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 by striking out all of paragraph I.

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment will reduce the funds to be deposited in the Capitol Repair Account within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management in an amount that can not be determined at this time.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the authority granted by the bill to the Adjutant General to sell a 2-acre parcel of land west of the Augusta Armory building.
