COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1586, L.D. 2217, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands to Grant a License for Groundwater Extraction at Range Ponds State Park"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Authorizing the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the Department of Conservation to collect certain revenues from a commercial entity in exchange for the extraction of groundwater may result in a significant amount of additional revenue to Maine State Parks and Recreational Facilities Development Fund beginning in fiscal year 1999-2000. The amounts of additional dedicated revenue can not be determined at this time.

The Bureau of Parks and Lands will incur some minor additional costs to administer the licensing process needed to allow a commercial entity to extract groundwater from Range Ponds State Park. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.'
