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Sec. 4. Use of revenues. Revenues from the extraction of groundwater authorized by this Act must be deposited into the

Maine State Parks and Recreational Facilities Development Fund

established by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 609.

SUMMARY

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This bill specifically authorizes the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands to grant a license to the Poland Spring Water Co. for commercial extraction of groundwater at Range Ponds State Park in Poland, Maine. Revenues generated by groundwater extraction at Range Ponds State Park will be deposited into the Maine State Parks and Recreational Facilities Development Fund, which is dedicated to repair, development and management projects that will enhance and expand public recreational opportunities.
