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

SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1592, L.D. 2221, Bill, "An Act to Dissolve the Ogunquit Sewer District and Establish a Sewerage Department"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "Sec.15." in the last paragraph in the last 2 lines (page 4, lines 11 and 12 in amendment) by striking out the following: 'but the trustees shall consider the results of the vote to be the will of voters of the district'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement that the Trustees of the Ogunquit Sewer District consider the results of a vote at a special meeting to be the will of the voters of the district.
