COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 826, L.D. 2224, Bill, "An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$16,000,000 to Construct Water Pollution Control Facilities; to Close and Clean Up Municipal Solid Waste Landfills; to Clean Up Tire Stockpiles; to Investigate, Abate, Clean Up and Mitigate Hazardous Substance Discharges; to Mitigate Storm Water Pollution through a Comprehensive Watershed Protection Program; and to Make Drinking Water System Improvements"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$12,500,000 to Construct Water Pollution Control Facilities; to Clean Up Tire Stockpiles; to Investigate, Abate, Clean Up and Mitigate Hazardous Substance Discharges; to Mitigate Storm Water Pollution through a Comprehensive Watershed Protection Program; and to Make Drinking Water System Improvements'

Further amend the bill in the Preamble in the 5th and 6th lines (page 1, lines 5 and 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "to close and clean up municipal solid waste landfills;"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 15 and 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "to close and clean up municipal solid waste landfills;"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 9th line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$16,000,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$12,500,000'

lines (page 1, lines 23 and 24 in L.D.) by striking out the
4 following: "to close and clean up municipal solid waste
landfills;"

6 Further amend the bill in section 6 in the 2nd and 3rd lines
(page 2, lines 12 and 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
8 "to close and clean up municipal solid waste landfills;"

10 Further amend the bill in section 6 in that part designated
"ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, DEPARTMENT OF" by
12 striking out all of the 4th and 5th lines (page 2, lines 25 and
14 26 in L.D.)

16 Further amend the bill in section 6 by striking out all of
the last line (page 2, line 46 in L.D.) and inserting in its
18 place the following:

'TOTAL ALLOCATIONS \$12,500,000'

20 Further amend the bill in section 10 in the question in the
22 first line (page 3, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "\$16,000,000" and inserting in its place the
24 following: '\$12,500,000'

26 Further amend the bill in section 10 in the question by
striking out all of subsection 2 (page 3, lines 37 to 39 in L.D.)
28

30 Further amend the bill in section 10 in the question by
renumbering the subsections consecutively.

32 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

36 The estimated cost of sending this bond issue out to
38 referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda
enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 118th
40 Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The
estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda
42 are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an
additional \$7,000.

46 If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue
is estimated to be \$15,593,750 with principal payments of
\$12,500,000 and interest payments of approximately \$3,093,750.
