SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1595, L.D. 2225, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Maine Commission on Children's Health Care"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after the first indented paragraph the following:

'Further amend the bill in Part A by striking out all of section 3 (page 7, lines 15 to 29 in L.D.)'

Further amend the amendment in section A-4 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$3,384,169" and inserting in its place the following: '\$3,382,199' and in the 3rd line (page 2, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$137,394" and inserting in its place the following: '\$139,364'

Further amend the amendment in section A-6 by striking out all of that part relating to "LEGISLATURE" (page 4, lines 25 to 47 in amendment)

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment reduces the General Fund appropriations in the bill by \$1,970 in fiscal year 1998-99. It also makes a corresponding reduction in the Children's Health Reserve Account lapsed balance in fiscal year 1998-99.
