	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6421-A is enacted to read:
4 6	<u>§6421-A. Moratorium on new licenses</u>
8	 Moratorium. Notwithstanding section 6421, subsection 5, the commissioner may not issue a Class I, Class II or Class III lobster and crab fishing license to a person between the
10	effective date of this section and December 31, 1999 unless that person:

14	A. Possessed a Class I, Class II or Class III lobster and crab fishing license in the previous calendar year;
16	<u>B. Possessed an apprentice lobster and crab fishing license</u> issued prior to February 13, 1998 and meets the requirements
18	of the apprentice program under section 6422; or
20	<u>C. Did not possess a Class I, Class II or Class III lobster</u> and crab fishing license in the previous calendar year
22	because the commissioner had suspended the person's license privileges for a length of time that included that previous
24	<u>calendar year.</u>
26	2. Repeal. This section is repealed January 1, 2000.

32	This bill enacts a moratorium on commercial lobster and crab fishing licenses. It provides that until December 31, 1999
34	commercial lobster and crab fishing licenses may only be issued to a person who held a license in the previous calendar year, who
36	possessed an apprentice lobster and crab fishing license issued prior to February 13, 1998 and meets the requirements of the
