This amendment is the majority report. It provides for amendments to the rules regarding the certification of needle exchange programs. The rule amendments:

Clarify that the one or more individuals that sign the application form must be ultimately responsible for the program operating in compliance with the rules;

Clarify that notification of changes in the program must be provided to the Bureau of Health within 10 days of the change; and

Specifically prohibit the assignment or transfer of the certification from one program to another.
