COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1607, L.D. 2234, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Rules Governing the Implementation of Hypodermic Apparatus Exchange Programs, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Human Services"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by inserting before the following: "authorized." the following: 'not'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Human Services will realize some minor savings from not granting authorization to certify these programs.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report. It specifically does not authorize final adoption of the rules regarding the certification of needle exchange programs. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
