SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1617, L.D. 2244, Bill, "An Act to Encourage Intergovernmental Cooperation"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2 and 3.


Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE
