22 Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2, 3 and 5.


24 Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any

30 **FISCAL NOTE**

32 This amendment removes the real estate transfer tax
34 provisions contained in the bill thereby eliminating the loss of
36 General Fund revenue and also removes the grant program to county
38 governments for pilot projects. No funding was provided for this
40 grant program.
