absorbed by the State House and Capitol Park Commission utilizing existing budgeted resources.

 Since the Legislature does not have any funding budgeted for the acquisition of portraits, additional General Fund
appropriations will be required. The fiscal years in which the appropriations will be required will depend upon the schedule
approved by the Legislative Council.'

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the bill and replaces it with the 14 recommendations of the Legislature to add Dora Bradbury Tinkham and Kate Douglas Wiggin to the list of those receiving official 16 recognition as outstanding Maine citizens.
