COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "" to H.P. 1621, L.D. 2251, Bill, "An Act to Permit Direct Contracting with State Governmental Entities for the Provision of Services to Eligible Participants in Covernment Health Programs"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the 2nd indented paragraph in the 19th line (page 1, line 47 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "<u>sufficiency</u>," the following: '<u>access to services</u>,'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 9 in paragraph A in the 5th line (page 3, line 25 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "<u>sufficiency</u>," the following: '<u>access to services</u>,'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 34 summary the following:

#### **FISCAL NOTE**

This bill increases the likelihood that the Department of 40 Human Services will have two managed care entities in a region by increasing the number of potential providers under the 42 department's managed care initiative, thereby permitting a mandatory managed care program. Savings within the Medicaid 44 program have been anticipated as a result of this managed care program.'
