HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 847, L.D. 2253, Bill, "An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$10,000,000 to Finance the Acquisition of Land for Conservation, Outdoor Recreation and Wildlife Habitat Protection and Farmland Preservation and to Access \$5,000,000 in Matching Contributions From Public and Private Sources"

Amend the amendment on page 2 in the first indented paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Board" the following: ', and at least 80% of the bond proceeds available must be expended for acquisition of land for public recreation in southern and coastal Maine'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that at least 80% of the bond proceeds available must be expended for acquisition of land for public recreation in the southern and coastal areas of the State.
