SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1631, L.D. 2259, Bill, "An Act to Preserve the State House and to Renovate State Facilities"


Amend bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

**Sec. 2. Consensus required to make expenditures.** Aside from costs associated with the design phase, no expenditure of funds may be made until a majority of the Legislative Council and the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services reach consensus regarding the allocation of space in the State Office Building.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment that requires a majority of the Legislative Council and the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services reach consensus regarding the allocation of space in the State Office Building before expenditure of funds other than funds for the design phase may be made.
