SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1631, L.D. 2259, Bill, "An Act to Preserve the State House and to Renovate State Facilities"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the next to last line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2/3" and inserting in its place the following: '2/3 majority'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the statutory requirement of 2/3 vote of the Legislature to a majority vote of the Legislature to approve actions of the Governmental Facilities Authority.
