SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1632, L.D. 2260, "Resolve, Charging the Children's Cabinet Agencies to Support Efforts of Parents as First Teachers of Their Children"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 26 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Services" the following: ', the Commissioner of Public Safety'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 2 (page 1, lines 37 to 44 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 2. Core curriculum for caregivers. Resolved: That, within available resources:

1. The Children's Cabinet shall develop a core curriculum that will be available to all Maine parents and caregivers by 1999;

2. The Children's Cabinet shall develop a training program for all caregivers and providers based on the core curriculum; and

3. State-funded home visiting services for families with children 0 to 5 years of age shall provide this information to parents; and be it further'
