COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1634, L.D. 2264, Bill, "An Act to Promote and Encourage the Cultivation of Cranberries in the State"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

1998-99

University of Maine System, Board of Trustees

All Other \$50,000

Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 7, section 2402 and any other provision of law, provides funds for a University of Maine Cooperative Extension Service integrated pest management program for cranberries including a position devoted primarily to cranberries.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$50,000 in fiscal year 1998-99 for the University of Maine System to establish an integrated pest management program for cranberries.

SUMMARY

The amendment appropriates \$50,000 directly to the University of Maine Cooperative Extension Service for an integrated pest management program for cranberries. It also adds a fiscal note.
