This amendment replaces the General Fund appropriation of \$85,000 in fiscal year 1998-99 to the Department of Labor with an Other Special Revenue allocation for the same amount. for this expenditure will be provided by an assessment levied by the Public Utilities Commission on telephone companies in the Funds collected by the commission will be deposited in Telecommunications Equipment Fund administered by Department of Labor.

This amendment also reduces the General Fund appropriation to the Legislature in fiscal year 1998-99 from \$1,420 to \$1,315.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment establishes an assessment to be levied by the Public Utilities Commission on telephone companies in the State to provide funding for the Telecommunications Equipment Fund within the Department of Labor. This amendment also deletes the General Fund appropriation for the Department of Labor, provides an Other Special Revenue allocation for the Department of Labor, reduces the General Fund appropriation to the Legislature and reduces the number of authorized meetings for the Commission to Study the Funding and Distribution of Teletypewriters and Other Telecommunications Equipment for People with Disabilities.
