The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the commission can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources.

The Division of Deafness within the Department of Labor will incur some minor additional costs to conduct a study and to submit a report to the Legislature. These costs can be absorbed within the division's existing budgeted resources.

The additional costs associated with conducting an annual survey of public schools to assess the need for specialized customer telecommunications equipment in school systems and reporting those findings to the Legislature can be absorbed by the Department of Education utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

This amendment clarifies that the Commission to Study the Funding and Distribution of Teletypewriters and Other Telecommunications Equipment for People with Disabilities may hold 2 additional meetings to further its study. The amendment authorizes the commission to report out legislation and requires the commission to report to the First Regular Session of the 119th Legislature by January 15, 1999.

The amendment also requires the Division of Deafness to consult with the Commission to Study the Funding and Distribution of Teletypewriters and Other Telecommunications Equipment for People with Disabilities and with other advisory councils representing the interests of persons with disabilities when developing its comprehensive plan for providing direct access to specialized customer telecommunications equipment. The Division of Deafness must also report to the First Regular Session of the 119th Legislature by January 15, 1999.
