COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 857, L.D. 2270

2 '"Do you favor amending the Constitution of Maine to require that a petition for a people's veto be voted on at the next
4 statewide election held in November, rather than at a special election ?"'

Further amend the resolution by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to 14 referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 118th 16 Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda 18 are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

If approved by the voters, this resolution may reduce costs to the Department of the Secretary of State by avoiding special elections in the event of a petition for a people's veto.'

SUMMARY

28 This amendment provides that an election on a people's veto must be held at a November statewide election, rather than 30 allowing the election to occur at any statewide or general election. If fewer than 60 days remain between the date of the 32 Governor's proclamation of referral to the voters and the immediate next November election, the election must be held 34 during the following November election.
