COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "4" to H.P. 1643, L.D. 2275, Bill, "An Act to Modify the Law Pertaining to Personal Sports Mobile Franchises"

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph O in subparagraph (2) in the 3rd line (page 1, line 43 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "mobile" the following: 'dealer in sales'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph R in subparagraph (2) in the 2nd line (page 2, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the comma after the following: "sources" and inserting in its place the following: ':'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph R in subparagraph (5) in division (b) in the 4th line (page 3, line 39 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "the" the following: 'pro rata portion of the'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill may reduce prosecutions for Class E crimes. If jail sentences are reduced, the savings to the counties are estimated to be \$86.45 per day per prisoner. These savings do not affect reimbursement by the State. The reduction in the number of prosecutions that would have resulted in a jail

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2 sentence and the resulting savings to the county jail system are  
3 expected to be insignificant.

4 The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from  
5 reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with  
6 the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the  
7 court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease  
8 General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

11 **SUMMARY**

12 This amendment corrects 2 errors in the text of the  
13 legislative document and makes an additional technical correction  
14 to the existing Personal Sports Mobile Business Practices Act.

16 The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
