This amendment authorizes the Office of the Public 6 Advocate's unobligated fiscal year 1996-97 Other Special Revenue balance of \$60,483 to be carried forward into fiscal year 1997-98 8 and provides an allocation of the same amount to support increased costs. It also reduces the All Other allocation in fiscal year 1998-99 by \$50,000 to provide the office with a total 10 increase of \$380,000 in fiscal year 1998-99.

#### SUMMARY

This amendment authorizes unspent funds in the Public 18 Advocate Regulatory Fund for fiscal year 1996-97 to be carried forward in their entirety for use in fiscal year 1997-98.

This amendment also reduces by \$50,000 the amount of the 22 allocation to the Office of the Public Advocate for fiscal year 1998-99 as proposed in the bill.
