SUMMARY

И" to H.P. 1650, L.D. 2281

This amendment authorizes final adoption of Chapter 32: Rules for the Licensing of Children's Day Care Facilities and Chapter 33: Rules for Home Day Care Providers as long as the Department of Human Services amends Chapter 33 prior to its final adoption. The rule must be amended to include a provision that allows children not to be immunized for religious or medical reasons. In the event of a disease outbreak, these children must be excluded from the home day care until the outbreak no longer exists or until they receive the necessary immunization.
