HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 1657, L.D. 2286, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Majority of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry Regarding Enhancing Forest Resource Assessment"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 8 the following:


'Sec. 9. 12 MRSA §8869, sub-§4-A is enacted to read:

4-A. Harvest levels. For landowners, species group harvesting and total harvesting activities may not exceed by a factor of 10 the rate of growth for any rolling 10-year average as defined in rules adopted by the commissioner.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits harvesting levels from exceeding growth levels by more than 10 times the rate of growth.
