Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the until 90 days Legislature do not become effective after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this resolve continues the elimination of the 118th Legislature of the per diem compensation payment for the Second 6 Special Session; and

Whereas, in order to apply to such a special session, this 10 resolve must take effect in advance of the 90-day period; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 14 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it 16

Legislative Sec. 1. compensation. **Resolved:** 18 That, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, members of the Legislature are not entitled to per diem 20 compensation payment for attendance at the Second Special Session 22 of the 118th Legislature.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

## FISCAL NOTE

This resolve will avoid unbudgeted per diem costs of as much 30 as \$18,600 per day that would be incurred by the Legislature during the Second Special Session of the 118th Legislature. 32
