SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1675, L.D. 2295, Bill, "An Act to Improve the Delivery of Mental Health Services to Children"

Amend the bill in Part A in section 1 in that part designated "~~§15003.~~" in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the 3rd line from the end (page 7, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "approval" and inserting in its place the following: 'comment'

Further amend the bill in Part A in section 1 in that part designated "~~§15003.~~" in subsection 3 by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

'Rules for managed care initially adopted under this subsection are major substantive rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A and when first adopted must be adopted following the procedure for such rules.'

Further amend the bill in Part A in section 1 in that part designated "~~§15004.~~" in subsection 2 in paragraph A in subparagraph (3) in the first line (page 12, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "approve" and inserting in its place the following: 'comment on'

Further amend the bill in Part B in section 1 by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph (page 14, lines 16 to 20 in L.D.).
