4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§9-H** is enacted to read:

6 9-H. Electricity sold to farmers. Electricity used
8 directly and primarily in commercial agricultural and
10 aquacultural production.

14 This bill exempts electricity used directly and primarily in
commercial agricultural and aquacultural production from the
sales tax.
