'FISCAL NOTE

This bill may reduce prosecutions for Class E crimes. If the number of jail sentences is reduced, the savings to the counties are estimated to be \$83.36 per day per prisoner. The amount of any reduction of jail time and the resulting savings to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.

The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from 10 reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the 12 court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

SUMMARY

18 This is the minority amendment of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

The amendment replaces the bill and changes the word "hunt" 22 to "shoot" and adds a requirement to the bill that the physician who certifies that a person is severely limited in the ability to 24 walk due to an arthritic, neurological or orthopedic condition must be a physician who specializes in the area of that person's 26 disability. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
