	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§20, ¶A, as amended by PL 1983, c.
4	797, $\S10$, is further amended to read:
б	A. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 8 $9-A$:
8	(1) A person may hunt migratory waterfowl from a motorboat in accordance with federal regulations;

12	(2) A person who has a valid Maine permit to carry a concealed weapon may have in or on a motor vehicle or trailer a loaded pistol or revolver covered by such
14	permit; and
16	(3) Paraplegics and, single or double amputees of the legs and anyone severely limited in the ability to walk
18	due to an arthritic, neurological or orthopedic
20	<u>condition as determined and certified by a licensed</u> <u>physician</u> may hunt from motor vehicles which <u>that</u> are not in motion.

26	This bill allows any person limited in the ability to walk by arthritis or similar health conditions to hunt from motor
28	vehicles that are not in motion.
