2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §4041, sub-§1, ¶B,** as enacted by PL 1989, c.
91, is amended to read:

6 B. "Livestock animal" means dairy, feeding, beef or breeding
8 cattle; horses; sheep; goats; donkeys; or swine; or wild
10 animals that are kept and raised domestically such as bison,
buffalo, deer and rabbits.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill adds wild animals that are kept and raised
16 domestically to the category of animals for which their owner can
be charged with animal trespass.
