Sec. 2. Application. This Act applies to appointments made after the effective date of this Act. Budget advisory committee members as of the effective date of this Act may serve out the remainder of their terms.'

SUMMARY

10 This amendment clarifies the intent of the original bill by amending the Oxford County Budget Advisory Committee selection 12 process to allow county commissioners to fill by appointment vacant budget committee seats in their respective districts in 14 the event that the annual district caucus fails to produce at least 2 qualified budget committee members. The amendment also 16 requires a county commissioner to give notice if the commissioner exercises budget advisory committee appointment authority. It 18 also prohibits a municipality from having more than one representative serving on the budget advisory 20 simultaneously.
