Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §135 is enacted to read:
§135. Firefighter's Recognition Day
In recognition of the value and importance of firefighters,
the State designates the first Saturday in October as
Firefighter's Recognition Day, The Governor shall annually issue
a proclamation urging the people of the State to observe the day
with appropriate celebration and activity.
SUMMARY

Firefighter's Recognition Day in the State.
