2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §135** is enacted to read:

6 **§135. Firefighter's Recognition Day**

8 In recognition of the value and importance of firefighters,  
10 the State designates the first Saturday in October as  
12 Firefighter's Recognition Day. The Governor shall annually issue  
14 a proclamation urging the people of the State to observe the day  
16 with appropriate celebration and activity.

14 **SUMMARY**

Firefighter's Recognition Day in the State.
