COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 16, L.D. 26, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Responsibility of a Municipality in Enforcing Personal Watercraft Regulations"

Amend the bill in section 1 in section 17 in the first paragraph in the 2nd line from the end (page 1, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following "enforce" and inserting in its place the following: 'enforce or'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will incur some minor additional costs to prepare and submit the required report. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment retains the current requirement that a municipality submit a description of the resources the municipality will use to enforce proposed regulations regarding the use, operation and type of watercraft on great ponds within the jurisdiction of that municipality.
