COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 20, L.D. 30, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 5: Standards for Continuing Professional Education for Acupuncturists and Naturopathic Doctors; Chapter 6: Standards Relating to Prescriptive Authorities and Collaborative Relationships; and Chapter 9: Fees, Section 1, Major Substantive Rules of the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "authorized." and inserting in its place the following: 'authorized with the following amendments to the rule:'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 by inserting at the end the following:

1. The reference to Lincomycin in Chapter 6, Section 3, subsection E(4) must be deleted.

2. The reference to Aminophylline in Chapter 6, Section 3, subsection E(8) must be deleted.

3. The reference to Theophylline in Chapter 6, Section 3, subsection E(8) must be deleted.'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency clause.

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SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report. The amendment strikes the emergency preamble and clause. This amendment also authorizes final adoption of Chapter 5: Standards for Continuing Professional Education for Acupuncturists and Naturopathic Doctors; Chapter 6: Standards Relating to Prescriptive Authorities and Collaborative Relationships; and Chapter 9: Fees, Section 1, provided several amendments are made to the proposed rule by the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation prior to its final adoption. The amendments must provide that:

1. The reference to Lincomycin in Chapter 6, Section 3, subsection E(4) must be deleted;
2. The reference to Aminophylline in Chapter 6, Section 3, subsection E(8) must be deleted; and
3. The reference to Theophylline in Chapter 6, Section 3, subsection E(8) must be deleted.
