COMMITTEE OF CONFERENCE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 20, L.D. 30, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 5: Standards for Continuing Professional Education for Acupuncturists and Naturopathic Doctors; Chapter 6: Standards Relating to Prescriptive Authorities and Collaborative Relationships; and Chapter 9: Fees, Section 1, Major Substantive Rules of the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "authorized" the following: 'with the following amendments to the rule: Chapter 6 must be revised to remove the authority for naturopathic doctors to prescribe Lincomycin, Aminophylline, Theophylline, allergy shots and nontopical steroids'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency clause.

SUMMARY

This is the unanimous report of the Committee of Conference.

The amendment strikes the emergency preamble and emergency clause. The amendment authorizes final adoption of Chapter 5: Standards for Continuing Professional Education for Acupuncturists and Naturopathic Doctors; Chapter 6: Standards Relating to Prescriptive Authorities and Collaborative Relationships; and Chapter 9: Fees, Section 1 provided that Chapter 6 is revised to remove the authority for naturopathic doctors to prescribe Lincomycin, Aminophylline, Theophylline, allergy shots and nontopical steroids.
