
**Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 8: Fees, Section 1, a  
Major Substantive Rule of the Board of Veterinary Medicine.**

2           **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the  
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after  
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6           **Whereas,** the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5,  
chapter 375, subchapter II-A, requires legislative authorization  
before major substantive agency rules may be finally adopted by  
8 the agency; and

10           **Whereas,** the above named major substantive rule has been  
submitted to the Legislature for review; and

14           **Whereas,** immediate enactment of this resolve is necessary to  
record the Legislature's position on final adoption of the rule;  
and

18           **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts  
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of  
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately  
20 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
safety; now, therefore, be it

22           **Sec. 1. Adoption. Resolved:** That final adoption of Chapter 8:  
24 Fees, Section 1, a provisionally adopted major substantive rule  
of the Board of Veterinary Medicine, and submitted to the  
26 Legislature for review pursuant to the Maine Administrative  
Procedure Act, is authorized.

28           **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the  
30 preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.
