	16	
		This amendment replaces the bill. It requires individual
	18	and group health insurance policies, health care services plans and other contracts that provide for the payment of surgical
	20	assistants to pay registered nurse first assistants for surgical assisting performed. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to

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the bill.
