	28	This bill will result in additional costs to the State Employee Health Insurance Program. Based on an estimate of the
	30	cost differential between the State's plan and other members of the Maine Health Management Coalition, the estimated additional
	32	annual costs that will be incurred by the State Plan range from \$1,200,000 to \$1,800,000, based on a 4.5% to 6.5% increase in the
	34	cost of reimbursement of non-hospital, professional services. In addition to these costs, the State Plan may be prohibited from
	36	realizing savings from reimbursements to hospitals. An estimate of the savings that may not be able to be realized as a result of
	38	this bill ranges from \$1,900,000 to \$2,800,000 annually.
	40	Based on a mid-range estimate of the additional cost, the General Fund share is approximately \$203,000 in fiscal year
	42	1999-00 and \$658,000 in fiscal year 2000-01; the Highway Fund share is \$86,000 and \$278,000; and the share for all other funds
	44	is \$170,000 and \$552,000. Additional General Fund appropriations, Highway Fund allocations and other fund
	46	allocations will likely be required to provide funding for these additional costs.'
