COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 27, L.D. 38, Bill, "An Act to Give the Probate Court Power to Order Child Support in Cases Involving Guardianship of a Minor"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "chapter 63" and inserting in its place the following: 'Part 3'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the cross-reference in the bill to include all of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 19-A, Part 3 to ensure that all aspects of child support calculation and enforcement apply to orders issued by the Probate Court when that court orders a parent to pay child support when a guardian is appointed for a child.
