

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

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**Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§12**, as repealed and replaced by PL 1991, c. 824, Pt. A, §21, is amended to read:

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**SUMMARY**

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Current law requires a person hunting during open firearm season to wear at least 2 articles of solid-colored hunter orange clothing. This bill reduces the requirement to one article of clothing that is at least 50% hunter orange.
