2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §8868, sub-§4**, as amended by PL 1997, c. 720,
§6, is further amended to read:

6 **4. Timber harvesting.** "Timber harvesting" means the
cutting or removal of more than 50 cords of timber for the
8 primary purpose of selling or processing forest products.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill amends the definition of timber harvesting by
14 adding the requirement that in order to be "timber harvesting"
more than 50 cords of timber must be cut or removed.

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
